

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Privacy Information

The Royal Commonwealth Society, Bath and District Branch (RCS Bath) is a constitutional association of members and therefore has a legitimate interest in processing necessary personal data of members to enable members to exercise their constitutional rights and to enable the organisation's officers to identify and communicate with members on governance and activity matters.

RCS Bath only obtains personal data from the relevant individual. Individuals are not under any statutory or contractual obligation to provide their personal data, but membership may be conditional on the provision of necessary personal data. Members are encouraged to inform RCS Bath of relevant personal data changes.

RCS Bath only provides the personal data to its members as required by the constitution. Members personal data will not be provided to other individuals, organisations or countries, unless specific consent is granted by those individuals or to comply with legal and regulatory requirements.

The retention period for personal data will be a nominal six years after the end of the tax year of termination of membership, subject to compliance with legal and regulatory requirements.

Individuals have the right to be informed about the collection and use of their personal data and the right to request personal data held on them. Individuals have the right to opt-out of marketing communications. Individuals have the right to lodge a complaint with relevant supervisory authorities (e.g. Information Commissioner's Office ico.org.uk).
